

# YOUR ICE CREAM SOCIAL PARTY PACK

## **Page 1 - The Invitations**

- Formatted as 5x7 inch (A7) invites, you will need the envelopes in that same size (A7).
- We recommend printing on heavy card stock, as bright white as you can find. (Such as 98 bright)

## **Page 2 - Address Labels**

- These labels are formatted for you to be able to type your addresses right into the document, and print. The font we have used throughout the Party Pack for most of the text is DeLouisville Small Caps. We recommend that you download that free font before you open the file to print it. That way, when you open Acrobat Reader with the file, you can type the text and it will match the invitations, etc.
- This is where you can find that font. Just install on your computer and then you can edit the file!

## **Page 3 - Square Buffet Tags**

- These square labels are meant to be tied onto different serving vessels with ribbon, or you can also mount them to popsicle sticks, lollipop sticks, etc. for labeling purposes, but we're sure you can think of many other uses for them!

## **Pages 4-16 - Party Banner**

- Here you will find every letter of the alphabet on 5" square banner blocks, just print on card stock and cut, then punch holes for ribbon to weave through!

### **Page 17 - Cupcake Toppers, Round Labels, Treat Bag Seals**

- These can be printed on letter sized sticker paper, or card stock depending on what you want to use them for. They will easily mount on popsicle sticks or lollipop sticks to use for cupcake toppers!

## **Page 18 - Straw Flags**

- Just print on sticker paper, cut, and attach to the top of a straw lining up with the dotted line in the center!
  - These flags have been formatted with text boxes that you can edit yourself in Acrobat Reader.

## **Page 19 - Thank Yous**

- These can be printed on card stock and cut down the middle, then scored and folded, or they can be printed on Avery Matte White Notecards. They fit perfectly on those. Just remember that they need to be printed borderlessly.
